Begin your trip in Gangtok, the charming capital of Sikkim, known for its picturesque viewpoints, bustling MG Marg, peaceful monasteries, and warm hospitality. Explore the city's attractions while enjoying panoramic views of the Eastern Himalayas. Travel to the stunning Tsomgo Lake (Changu Lake), a glacial lake nestled at an altitude of approximately 12,300 feet. Surrounded by majestic mountains, the lake changes its colors with the seasons, offering spectacular views throughout the year. Visitors can also enjoy yak rides and admire the pristine alpine scenery. Continue to the iconic Nathula Pass, one of the highest motorable mountain passes in the world, situated on the historic Silk Route along the India–China border. Witness breathtaking Himalayan vistas and experience the unique atmosphere of this strategically important border crossing (subject to permits and weather conditions). The journey then takes you to Lachung, a picturesque Himalayan village renowned for its snow-covered peaks, waterfalls, apple orchards, and traditional mountain lifestyle. Surrounded by untouched natural beauty, Lachung serves as the gateway to the enchanting Yumthang Valley. The peaceful environment and fresh mountain air make it an ideal destination for nature lovers and adventure seekers. This tour offers an ideal combination of natural beauty, adventure, culture, and unforgettable Himalayan experiences, making it a perfect getaway for families, couples, groups, and honeymooners.

TRIP HIGHLIGHT

Arrival and departure from Gangtok, the capital of Sikkim. Scenic drive through the Eastern Himalayas with breathtaking mountain landscapes. Visit to the serene Tsomgo Lake, a glacial lake surrounded by snow-capped peaks. Explore the sacred Baba Harbhajan Singh Memorial Temple. Excursion to Nathula Pass (subject to permit and weather conditions), one of India's highest motorable mountain passes on the Indo-China border. Discover Gangtok's vibrant local markets, cafés, and handicraft shops along MG Marg. Visit peaceful monasteries such as Rumtek Monastery or Enchey Monastery. Enjoy panoramic Himalayan views, local Sikkimese cuisine, and warm hospitality. Ideal blend of nature, spirituality, culture, and adventure in a short Himalayan getaway.

- Yumthang Valley – Often called the "Valley of Flowers," known for alpine meadows, rivers, and snow-capped peaks.
- Zero Point (Yumesamdong) – A high-altitude destination (about 15,300 ft) where roads end and snow is often present for much of the year.
- Lachung Village – A picturesque Himalayan village with traditional Bhutia culture, wooden homes, and scenic mountain views.
- Lachung Monastery – A peaceful Buddhist monastery offering panoramic views of the surrounding valley.
- Bhim Nala Waterfall (Amitabh Bachchan Falls) – One of the tallest and most impressive waterfalls in North Sikkim.
- Local Sikkimese cuisine – Enjoy dishes like momos, thukpa, gundruk, and butter tea at local eateries.

YOUR JOURNEY

Day 1 — GANGTOK TO TSOMGO NATHULA - NEW BABAMANDIR

Today we will visit Tsomgo, Nathula, Babamandir after departing from Gangtok. As we complete the breakfast we will leave for Tsomgo Lake, which is located at an elevation of 12400 feet and 15 meters deep. The chilled water in the lake drives down after the melting of snow. This lake is considered to be a sacred lake by the local people. In the ancient period, the future could be predicted by the Lamas after looking at the colour of the lake. Over here you can experience the joy ride and the ropeway. Later that visit Babamandir located on the way to Nathula pass at a height of 15,000 ft. This Baba mandir carries a very heart touching story about an Indian soldier. Nathula pass is subject to permit system where you need to pay extra cost. Stay over night at Gangtok.

Day 2 — GANGTOK TO LACHUNG

Today we will be heading towards Lachung via Chungthang confluence - En-route Singhik View point, Naga Falls and Bhim Nala waterfall. Arrive Lachung by evening. Dinner & Overnight stay at Lachung.

Day 3 — LACHUNG SIGHTSEEING

Early Morning drive to Yumthang-valley (known as Valley of Flowers), Yumthang is the summer grazing ground of the Yaks & winter playgrounds of Yetis. On the way back visit Hot Spring considered to have medicinal properties. Back to resort for lunch. Stay at Lachung.

Day 4 — LACHUNG TO GANGTOK

After breakfast, check out from your hotel and begin your return journey towards Gangtok. Enjoy a smooth and comfortable drive through the scenic mountain roads. Upon arrival in Gangtok, check in to your hotel and relax after the long drive. Overnight, stay at Gangtok

Not Included

- Airfare, Train tickets, or any transportation not mentioned in the inclusion

- Lunch, snacks, beverages, and meals other than those specified
- Entry fees, camera charges, and optional activity charges at sightseeing places
- Nathula Pass visit charge (subject to availability of permit)
- Heater charges in hotels wherever applicable.

TRAVEL TIPS

March–May: Rhododendrons in bloom and pleasant weather. October–December: Clear skies and excellent mountain views. December–February: Snowfall (road conditions may vary). June–September: Monsoon season; landslides can affect travel. Carry a government-issued photo ID. Indian citizens need permits for North Sikkim (including Lachung), usually arranged by local tour operators. Foreign nationals have additional permit requirements. Book North Sikkim tours in advance, especially during peak seasons (March–May and October–December). Keep both digital and printed copies of your ID and travel bookings. Best time to visit March to May: Pleasant weather with blooming flowers. October to December: Clear mountain views and crisp weather. June to September: Heavy rains can cause landslides and road closures. January to February: Snow is possible around Lachung, but roads may occasionally close. Packing essentials Warm layers, even in summer (especially for Lachung). Waterproof jacket and sturdy shoes. Sunscreen, sunglasses, and lip balm (UV exposure is stronger at altitude). Power bank and flashlight. Basic medicines, including medication for motion sickness if you're prone to it. Lachung is at around 2,700 m (8,900 ft). Stay hydrated. Avoid alcohol on your first night at higher altitude. Eat light meals. If you experience severe

headache, vomiting, or difficulty breathing, seek medical help immediately. Road travel Roads to Lachung are scenic but winding. Start early, as mountain travel often begins before sunrise. Keep snacks and water in the vehicle. Expect limited mobile connectivity in some stretches. Money Carry sufficient cash, as ATMs become scarce outside Gangtok. UPI works in many places in Gangtok but may be unreliable in remote areas due to poor network coverage. Mobile network Networks work well in Gangtok. Coverage becomes patchy in North Sikkim. Download offline maps before leaving Gangtok. Food Try local specialties such as: Momos Thukpa Phagshapa (for non-vegetarians) Gundruk soup Chhurpi (traditional yak cheese) Responsible travel Don't litter in the mountains. Carry back plastic waste where possible. Respect monastery etiquette—remove shoes where required and ask before photographing monks. Avoid picking alpine flowers or disturbing wildlife

All payments must be made in full and on time to ensure uninterrupted services. **MANDATORY DOCUMENTATION FOR INDIAN CITIZENS:** - One recent passport-size photograph per traveler - Valid ID proof: Voter ID, Passport, or Driving License only - PAN cards and Aadhaar cards are not accepted as valid travel ID - For minors (under 18 years): Birth certificate is mandatory **FOR FOREIGN NATIONALS:** - Valid passport, visa, and four (4) passport-size photographs - Diplomatic passports or visas are not permitted for entry into Sikkim unless prior clearance is obtained from the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) or the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA)

CANCELLATION
