YOUR JOURNEY

Day 1 — ARRIVAL IN KATHMANDU

Arrival at Kathmandu International Airport. Meet & greet by our representative. Transfer to the hotel and check-in. Evening free to explore the vibrant Thamel Market. Overnight stay in Kathmandu.

Day 2 — KATHMANDU SIGHTSEEING

After breakfast, proceed for a full-day sightseeing tour covering: Pashupatinath Temple, Boudhanath Stupa, Swayambhunath Stupa (Monkey Temple), Kathmandu Durbar Square. Return to the hotel. Overnight stay in Kathmandu.

Day 3 — KATHMANDU TO POKHARA

After breakfast, drive to Pokhara through scenic mountain roads alongside rivers. Upon arrival: Check-in at the hotel. Evening walk around Lakeside Market. Optional boating on Phewa Lake. Overnight stay in Pokhara.

Day 4 — POKHARA SIGHTSEEING

Early morning excursion to: Sarangkot for sunrise over the Himalayas. Later visit: Devi's Fall, Gupteshwor Mahadev Cave, Bindhyabasini Temple, International Mountain Museum. Evening free at leisure. Overnight stay in Pokhara.

Day 5 — POKHARA TO NAGARKOT

Drive towards Nagarkot via Kathmandu. Upon arrival: Check-in at the hotel. Enjoy the spectacular Himalayan sunset. Overnight stay in Nagarkot.

Day 6 — NAGARKOT TO BHAKTAPUR TO KATHMANDU

Wake up early for a breathtaking Himalayan sunrise. After breakfast visit: Bhaktapur Durbar Square, Pottery Square, Nyatapola Temple, Local handicraft market. Proceed to Kathmandu. Overnight stay in Kathmandu.

Day 7 — DEPARTURE

After breakfast : Check out from the hotel. Transfer to Kathmandu International Airport. Tour ends with wonderful memories of Nepal.

- Accommodation for 06 Nights / 07 Days in the selected hotels.
- All transfers and sightseeing by a private air-conditioned vehicle (vehicle as per group size).
- Airport pick-up and drop at Kathmandu International Airport.

- Pokhara sightseeing as per the itinerary.
- Nagarkot and Bhaktapur excursion as per the itinerary.
- Driver allowance, fuel charges, parking fees, and toll taxes.

Not Included

- International or domestic airfare/train fare.
- Nepal Visa charges (if applicable).
- Monument entrance fees, camera/video charges, and guide charges.
- Boating charges at Phewa Lake.
- Adventure activities such as paragliding, zip-lining, bungee jumping, ultra-light flights, mountain flights, rafting, ATV rides, etc.
- Cable car tickets, pony rides, or any optional sightseeing not mentioned in the itinerary.

TRAVEL TIPS

Nepal's official currency is the Nepalese Rupee (NPR). Indian Rupee notes of ₹100 are widely accepted, while acceptance of higher denomination notes may vary, so carry sufficient local currency or exchange money at authorized counters. The best time to visit Nepal is March to May and September to November, when the weather is pleasant and the Himalayan views are at their best. Temperatures can vary significantly between mornings, evenings, and daytime. Carry warm clothing, especially when visiting Nagarkot, Sarangkot, or higher-altitude areas. Wear comfortable walking shoes, as many temples, heritage sites, and viewpoints involve walking and climbing steps. Dress modestly while visiting temples and religious sites. Remove shoes before entering temples and follow local customs. Stay hydrated throughout the journey and carry a reusable water bottle. Drink bottled or purified water whenever possible. Photography may be restricted inside certain temples and monasteries. Always check local guidelines before taking photographs. Respect local traditions, wildlife, and the natural environment. Avoid littering and help preserve Nepal's beautiful landscapes. Adventure activities such as paragliding, zip-lining, ultra-light flights, bungee jumping, and boating are optional and subject to weather conditions and operational availability. Travel times in Nepal may vary due to mountain roads, weather, and traffic. Plan your schedule with some flexibility.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

PAYMENT TERMS: - A non-refundable advance payment of 50% of the total tour cost is mandatory to confirm your itinerary. - 30% of the total cost must be paid upon arrival in Gangtok. - The remaining 20% must be paid prior to departure from Gangtok. Note: Failure to adhere to the payment schedule will result in immediate cancellation of the itinerary without any refund or compensation. All payments must be made in full and on time to ensure uninterrupted service

CANCELLATION
